SALTBURN PHOTOGRAPHIC SOCIETY POLICY REGARDING USE OF COMPETITION ENTRIES

Copyright of a photograph remains with the creator. This is the most important point about the following document. Members are asked to allow the Society to use images under the following conditions. Further permissions will be sought where necessary.

- 1. **Pictures entered for internal competition**: The member hereby consents that the Society may use these pictures for publication on the Society website, the Society Members Group Facebook page and for Society Presentations to other clubs in an exchange of work or to the public at Society functions.
- 2. **Summer Challenge**: The member hereby consents that the Society may use these pictures in Society Presentations. Also, with the permission of the author, these images could also be considered for use on the Society website and the Society Members Group Facebook page and, possibly, for inter-club competitions.
- 3. Pictures entered for external competitions: SPS is part of the NYSDPA and the NCPF, which organize competitions between clubs on a regional basis. SPS members will always be invited to take part in these competitions. By entering such competitions, the member consents that a regional body may publicise successful images on its website. Additionally, images entered into NCPF competitions may be selected to represent NCPF in PAGB National Inter-Federation competitions and may be included in an annual portfolio presentation of work which is circulated to all member clubs. Images that are used in the PAGB competitions may be publicised on the PAGB website.
- 4. **Photographs for external publicity purposes** e.g. the main SPS public Facebook page; local newspapers; magazines or local external websites, may be used only with the specific permission of the photographer. Such permission must be obtained by the Publicity Secretary by direct request to the photographer in question before any photograph is used for such a purpose.
- 5. Photographs of children may only be used on any forum with the direct permission of the photographer.
